IIJ Awarded “Best Service Provider of Year 2002” in Nikkei Survey

-- Ranked #1 in three qualifying categories of Broadband, Dedicated Access and Dialup Access --

TOKYO, December 2, 2002 – Internet Initiative Japan Inc. (“IIJ”, NASDAQ: IIJ), Japan’s leading Internet access and comprehensive network solutions provider, today announced that the Company was awarded the title ‘best service provider of year 2002’ in a major annual survey conducted by Nikkei Communications, a leading telecom industry trade magazine. According to the survey, which encompassed responses from 856 corporations in Japan and was released today, IIJ was ranked number one in three of the four total qualifying categories — “broadband service,” “dedicated access service” and “dialup access service.” IIJ ranked number two in the remaining “web server hosting service” category. The 2002 results follow the Company’s number one rankings in 2001 in all three qualifying categories: “dedicated Access”, “dialup Access” and “hosting/housing”.

“I’m very pleased with this award as it is a result of our continuous effort of ensuring high quality services that earn the trust of customers,” said Koichi Suzuki, the President and CEO of IIJ. “As the broadband network environment becomes standard in Japan, our responsibility for securing high network performance and a safe network environment is bringing an increased appreciation for IIJ’s services. We will continue to pursue our advanced expertise in IP technology and to strengthen our position in the marketplace as a provider of unparalleled comprehensive network solutions.”

The Nikkei Communications survey consisted of questions on customer satisfaction in each qualifying category for 11 items including price, network stability, throughput, customer support, security, backbone capacity, operation, the number of access points, server management, value-added services and consulting capabilities. Following IIJ as the best service provider of year 2002, the survey respondents ranked Nifty second and NTT Communications third in broadband service; PoweredCom second and JENS third in dedicated access service; and NEC second and Nifty third in dialup access service.
